



HONOR

Leader: Honor....

ALL: "Outdo one another in showing honor." Romans 12:9-10

Leader: What does it mean to show honor?

ALL: To treat others with respect and dignity

Leader: Why should we do this?

ALL: Because every person is an image of God

Leader: What does honor look like?

ALL: Honor is shown through words, actions, posture, and eye contact

SELF CONTROL

Leader: Self-control....

ALL: "For the grace of God has appeared... training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives" Titus 2:11-12

Leader: What does it mean to have self-control?

ALL: To use wisdom in how we speak, how we move our bodies, and how we respond with our emotions

Leader: Why should we do this?

ALL: A gift can be used to worship God or worship self; when we use it to worship God, we are following His best plan for us.

Leader: What does self-control look like?

ALL: Speaking with wisdom, moving our bodies with wisdom, and controlling our emotions with wisdom.



STEWARDSHIP

Leader: Stewardship...

ALL: "As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace." 1 Peter 4:10

Leader: What does it mean to be a steward?

ALL: To carefully and responsibly manage what has been given to us

Leader: What are things that God calls us to steward well?

ALL: Myself, my relationships, my education, my surroundings

Leader: What does this look like for you, {student}?

WISDOM

Leader: Wisdom...

ALL: "But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits, impartial and sincere." James 3:17

Leader: Where can we find wisdom?

ALL: In Scripture, from authorities, and through prayer.

Leader: What is the key to growing in wisdom?

ALL: Humility

Leader: What does wisdom look like?

ALL: Wisdom is NOT a checklist of "good behavior" but a heart that seeks the good, the true, and the beautiful in every situation.
